She is one of the Working Dogs for Conservation at Conservation South Luangwa. The dogs play a crucial role in detecting ivory, bushmeat, guns and ammunition, lion bones and skins, leopard skins and pangolins at the national park's boundary and across Zambia's Eastern Province.



Chai is a Dutch Shepherd who was donated to Working Dogs for Conservation (WD4C) due to her extremely high play drive and energy levels. Not the type of dog that would make an easy pet, she has turned into an outstanding working dog who loves to work with her brother, Earl. Initially trained in Montana by WD4C, both dogs continued their training when they moved to Zambia in 2015.
